The papers reflect on every aspect of Howe's varied career. Born in Nova Scotia in 1804, Howe began to work in his father's printing shop at an early age. As owner and editorof the Novascotian and as member of the Legislative Assembly, he emerged during the 1830's as one of the Province's most prominent reformers. In the reform campaign to obtain responsible government he played a leading role. During the Crimean War he endeavoured to recruit men secretly in the United States for service with the British force. His efforts to obtain financial assistance for the construction of railways in Nova Scotia led, in 1854, to his appointment as Chairman of the Railway Board, a position which he held for three years. In 1863 he withdrew from provincial politics and was appointed a Fishery Commissioner by the British Government. Upon his retirement from this office in 1866 he became leader of the anti-Confederation movement in Nova Scotia. After having obtained "better terms" for his province, Howe agreed to join Sir John A. Macdonald's wabinet as Secretary of State for the Provinces in 1869. Four years later he was appointed Liewtenant-Governor in his native province, but his health hadfailed and within a few weeks, on June 1, 1873, he died at Halifax.

The arrangement of the papers contains some obvious inconsistencies, but because of the numerous published references to the papers, it has been retained. Presented by Joseph Howe's son, Sydenham, in 1912. The George Johnson papers, relating primarily to Johnson's biography of Howe, were formerly considered to be a subsection of the Howe papers, but they are now organized as a separate unit dec me!
