3. Incomplete recollections of Joseph Letson (1809-1893) who operated  
Letson's Tannery on Letson's Lane (now Wright Avenue), Halifax.
4. E.M. Letson to Garry D. Shutlak, Port Medway, 19 November 1972.  
Gives permission to use Howe material for a display. "In my garden are 'Joe Howes' a blue belled flower brought to us by him. All his supporters wore them as blue was the Liberal colour".
5. Certificate of character for Joseph J. Letson signed by residents of Port Medway, 10 April 1850 and endorsed by Joseph Howe, 16 May 1850.
6. Appoint of Joseph Jones Letson as Collector of Colonial Duties at Port Medway, 6 May 1857.
7. Joseph Howe to "Dear Joe" (Letson) \_\_\_ 5 February \_\_\_, Letter stating he has forwarded a note on demand for £130.
8. Joseph Howe to "Dear Joe", Halifax, 20 October 1849. Letter expressing regret at the news of the death of Mrs. Letson, mother of Joseph Letson.
9. Joseph Howe to \_\_\_, Halifax, 2 April 1852. Letter authorizing an individual to draw on him for £100.
10. Marguerite Letson to Phyllis (Blakeley), Port Medway, 7 November 1972. Letter concerning material about Joseph Howe which has been placed in the Public Archives.
11. Certificate of qualification for common school teacher, Joseph Letson, County of Norfolk, 13 July 1852.
12. Notes by Joseph Letson on recollection of his life, written in 1893.
