#### Addenda To Family Of William Young

2<sup>nd</sup> generation John and Agnes with their children emigrated from Glasgow, Scotland on April 25, 1814 arriving in Halifax, Nova Scotia June 30, 1814. They moved to their estate called Willow Park on May 19, 1819.

Agnes Renny's father was George Renny born ca. 1752, dies Nov. 16, 1820 in Falkirk, Scotland. Agnes has at least one sister, Christian Renny, who married Jane Thomson.

John Young became famous as the writer of agricultural letters and articles under the pen name of Agricola. In various records he is referred to as "Hon John Young".

3<sup>rd</sup> generation. William Young was knighted by Her Majesty, Queen Victoria, for meritorious service in 1869. (Ed.- I believe his was one of the last titles bestowed in Canada)

Removed from Halifax to Prince Edward Island Sept 24, 1832 where he “became as prominent in Prince Edward Island as Sir William in Nova Scotia”. (Journal of Education).

4<sup>th</sup> generation. John Brooking Young drowned in the foundering of City of Boston Steamship off the coast of the continent. “(This steamer) left Halifax for Liverpool. G.B. January 28, 1870 and was never heard of after leaving port.” – Annals of North British Society, p. 413. (Ed.: Just how the date of January 31 for his death, reported elsewhere, was arrived at, defies speculation.)

His widow Bishop of Kentucky remarried. It is known only that her name became Abbot. At least one daughter (Ella) was born to this marriage and one son (Almon) who became the Episcopal.
