song of her praise; changes note of
music. Seems to have modern
touch

6 Fear à Bhatc, sung by Mr. Lauchie
Gillis. Mr. Alex Morrison of Marion
Bridge; have better versions

7 In gline Cuach, love song,
rarely sung, well sung by Lauchie
Gillis, but not complete, says
are 6 or 7 more vs. May McLeod has longer
version from Grand Nervous. Air
probably not known ~~here~~ elsewhere.

8 Isle of My Heart, Lauchie Gillis; well
known & on discs.

9 Drowning in Sound of Mull, well sung
by Mr. Angus McLellan; very old song,
best on tape: from Invernesshire, Scot-
land. Must be 400 or 500 yrs. old. Probably
never printed; good deep voice
