# Report of the Public Archives of Nova Scotia

FOR THE YEAR 1941

---

To the Board of Trustees of the Public Archives of Nova Scotia

Gentlemen:

I have the honour to present my eleventh annual report as archivist of Nova Scotia.

From the long distance point of view this has been one of the most eventful years in the history of the Archives, as the building has been thoroughly overhauled by the Department of Public Works, and, it is hoped, made safe and dry for many years to come; but from the immediate point of view it has been rather distracting to staff and students within the building. During most of the year the normal quiet has been broken by the activities of the workmen, inside and out, while staff and students had to move from room to room, along with their books and documents, as the work proceeded. Moreover, when the repairs had been completed, considerable time and energy were consumed in cleaning and replacing the collections or rearranging them on walls and shelves. But the building was not closed for a single day on that account, nor the regular work of the Archives discontinued, although the number of visitors was somewhat diminished and the meditations of students somewhat disturbed.

In order to accommodate those who may have been discouraged from visiting the Archives whilst it was under repair, or who could not do so during our regular hours, the building has been opened on Wednesday evenings since the first of November and will be opened on those evenings throughout the winter months. Though fewer visitors have registered this year than last, they have come from many parts of Canada, the United States and the British Isles not hitherto represented, as well as from Newfoundland, Bermuda, Southern Rhodesia, Australia, New Zealand and China.

The librarian reports that 1580 books and 1360 manuscript volumes have been used by research students and that a supplementary catalogue of 950 books, pamphlets and miscellaneous items in the Akins Library has been completed during the year.



As part of our contribution to the reorganization of the Provincial Museum, 1350 photographs of people, houses, inns and other public buildings in Nova Scotia have been transferred to the Archives. These, together with our own unframed photographs, have been catalogued carefully, so as to be readily accessible, and have already been consulted frequently. At the same time we transferred more than 400 books, pamphlets and maps, which have been incorporated in our modern library.

In pursuance of our general policy of working over some of our material each year for calendars or bulletins, two important sets of papers have been dealt with since our last report: those on Agriculture, 1815-1873, and on the Treasury up to 1840. The former have been finally arranged in twenty-seven manuscript volumes as the correspondence of Agricola, the Central Boards of Agriculture and the Local Societies, and the latter in 228 volumes under various sub-divisions of revenue, expenditure and public debt. Only one bulletin, "A Documentary Study of Provincial Finance and Currency, 1812-36", prepared by Dr. J. S. Martell, has been printed this year; but others are in preparation, and work on a more ambitious programme of publication is in progress.

Throughout the year many researches have been directed in the Archives, many enquiries have been answered by mail or telephone, and not a few long distance historians have been assisted in obtaining material for their collections or publications. At the same time every effort has been made to gather into the Archives all current publications by Nova Scotians, or in any way related to Nova Scotia, as also to fill any gaps in our collections of other days.

Appendix A contains a list of books, documents and pictures placed in our custody during the year, and shows that the Archives is being more generally recognized as the proper guardian of historical material, both public and private. In addition to those of our regular contributors, Sir Joseph Chisholm, Mr. B. E. Paterson and Dr. Falconer, the contributions of Messrs. G. N. Bayne, R. M. Hattie, Norman F. Yeigh and Mrs. G. E. E. Nichols deserve special notice.

Appendix B contains a list of settlers victualled at the public expense during the summer of 1750. The list has been preserved among the Deschamps manuscripts, and is especially interesting because of the large number of New England names it contains, thereby confirming the statements of contemporary correspondents that about a thousand New Englanders had arrived in Halifax within the first year of its founding, and that they insisted on being victualled on the same basis as those who had been sent direct from England by the Board of Trade. Incidentally, this list shows

that it was not only the poorer settlers who drew their rations from the public stores, as the names of Morris, Gibtors, Monk, Duport, Nesbitt, Hinchelwood, Green, Gerrish, Little, Cooke, Grant, Cleveland, Moreau, Mauger, Pierpont, Hancock, Lawson and Fairbanks mingle with those which do not appear again in public documents.
