Statement of Catherine Ann O'Reilley, age 16 yrs., residing at 23 Cross St., Sydney

Q. Do you know Donald Jr. Marshall  
A. Yes.

Q. How long

A. Since last Summer

Q. Do you keep co. with him

A. Several times this year. The last time about 1 week before the stabbing took place

Q. were you talking to him since the stabbing

A. Yes

Q. Where

A. On the phone -almost every day, until he went to Jail. He got his telephone no. changed

Q. What was the conversation.

A. He told me he was down at the park with Sandy Seale and 2 guys came over and asked him for a cigarette and when they said no, the men started to call them Blackie & that. He said one man was old & grey. He said he got stabbed in the arm. He said he ran to get help. He went to a house to use a phone. The man did not want him to use it but then he let him use it.

Q. Did he know these fellows

A. No

Q. Did you ever see Jr. Marshall with a knife

A. Yes last year down at the Park

Q. was it a large one

A. About 5½" blade

Q. What was he doing with it

A. Sticking it in the trees

Q. Did you see Jr. Marshall the night of May 28

A. Yes, I was sitting in a car in Tobin's yard, Intercolonial St. with Frankie French, Moose Tobin, Margie O'Reilley, my sister, Jr. Marshall, Ardie Paul, Dave McDonald.

Q. What time was this

A. Everyone was there till 12:45 A.M. except Moose Tobin, Frank French &amp; Jr. Marshall. They left about 10:30 P.M.

Q. Where did they go

A. They said they were going to St. Joseph's Dance

A. Did you or anybody else have anything to drink that night in the car

A. I never saw it

Q. Did Tobin, French and Marshall come back to the car

A. Tobin and French

Q. Where did they part from Marshall

A. They said they lost him and never found him

Q. ~~Why~~ why did Jr. Marshall leave you and go to the dance by himself

A. Because I was with Ardie Paul

Q. Did anybody have anything to drink in your presence that night

A. Yes Ardy Paul, Moose Tobin and Jr. Marshall - 1 pt. of liquor

Q. Did you see Jr. Marshall fighting at any time

A. Yes with his brother Pius and another fight down the Park. The guys were from westmount. This was last Summer.
